ShotSpotter Approved By Town Commission

The Town Commission is moving forward to install ShotSpotter technology in strategic locations throughout Lake Park.

ShotSpotter is a system that identifies where a weapon has been fired and immediately sends the information to law enforcement responding to the scene.

The system is part of a greater campaign by the Town to create a state-of-the-art public safety system. Other efforts include a network of cameras as well as license plate readers.

The Commission approved a 5-year deal for the ShotSpotter system. The cost of the system is being covered by existing funds, including unused salary and reserves.
