Lake Park Lands New Microbrewery and Restaurant New Jobs Coming

Have a drink! Have a job! Town leaders are "bubbling over" with excitement about news that the town's Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) has landed a deal that will bring a new microbrewery and restaurant to town. In addition to the economic redevelopment impact, the new business will also create new jobs in Lake Park.

Craft breweries have proven to be excellent anchors for redeveloping areas. One of the most notable success stories is just down I-95 in Oakland Park, Florida. The opening of the Funky Buddha brewery has led to an economic turnaround in a section of Oakland Park that desperately needed some redevelopment.

The new future hot spot is the latest community improvement to come out cooperation with the Lake Park CRA. The Lake Park CRA has made other noticeable improvements. The streetscape improvements along Park Avenue and 10th Street along with Arts District Commerce District Hometown District the alleyway improvements behind the Park Avenue businesses have enhanced the area and made it more inviting to businesses, as well as customers.
