Please be advised that during the Special Call Commission Meeting of the Lake Park Town Commission, it will hold a private session in accordance with Section 255.065(15)(d)1., Fla. Stat. to update the Commission on the negotiation process for a public private partnership (P-3) Qualifying Project involving the potential redevelopment of the Lake Park Harbor Marina. The Town Commission will convene the Special Call meeting in the Commission Chamber of Town Hall and then move into the Mirror Ballroom for the private meeting on **Wednesday, January 26, 2022** which begins at **7:00 p.m.** at 535 Park Avenue, Lake Park, Florida.

It is expected that the private meeting will be attended by: Mayor Michael O'Rourke, Vice-Mayor Kimberly Glas-Castro, Commissioners Erin T. Flaherty, John Linden and Roger Michaud, as well as Town Attorney, Thomas J.
