

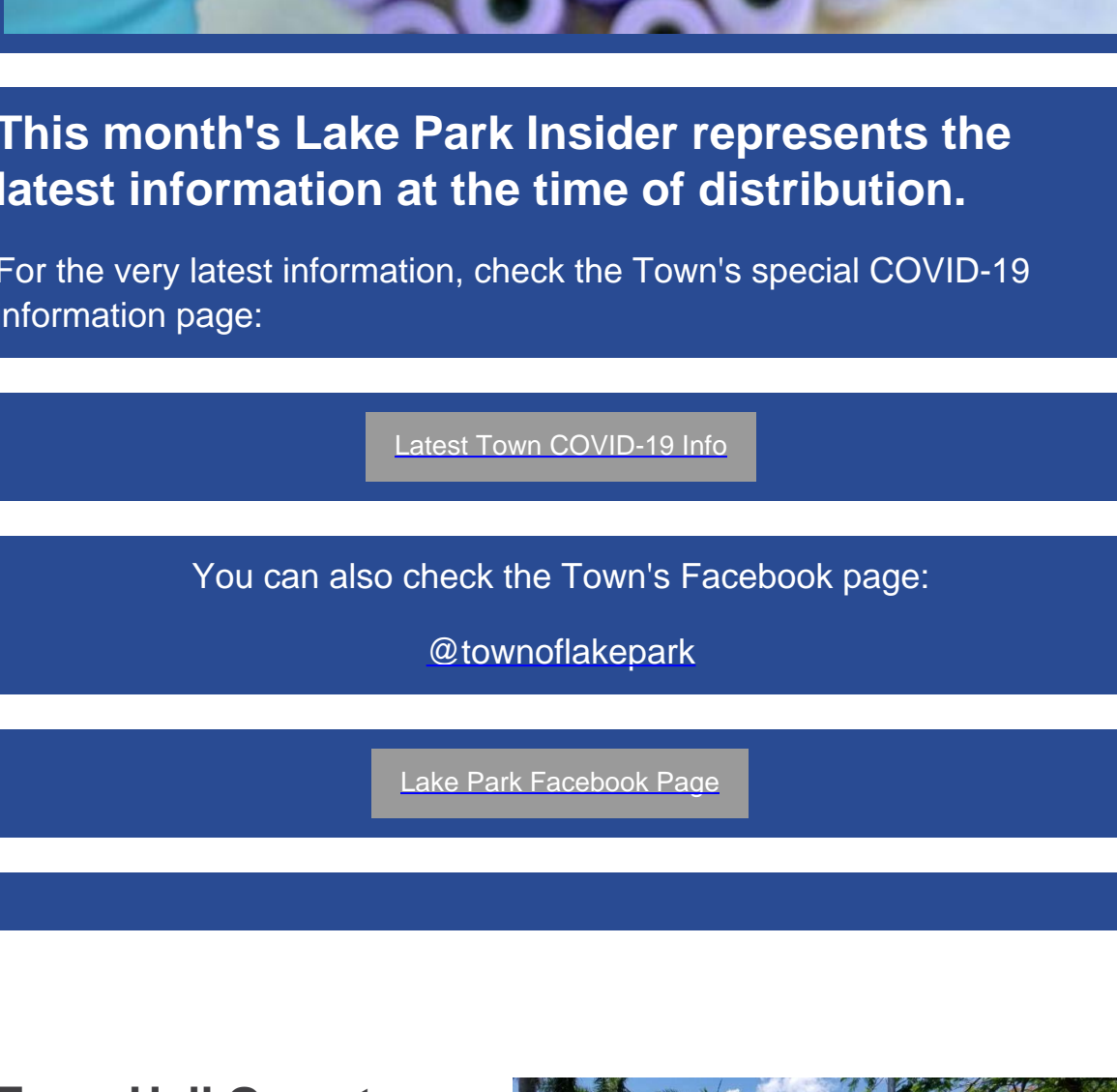

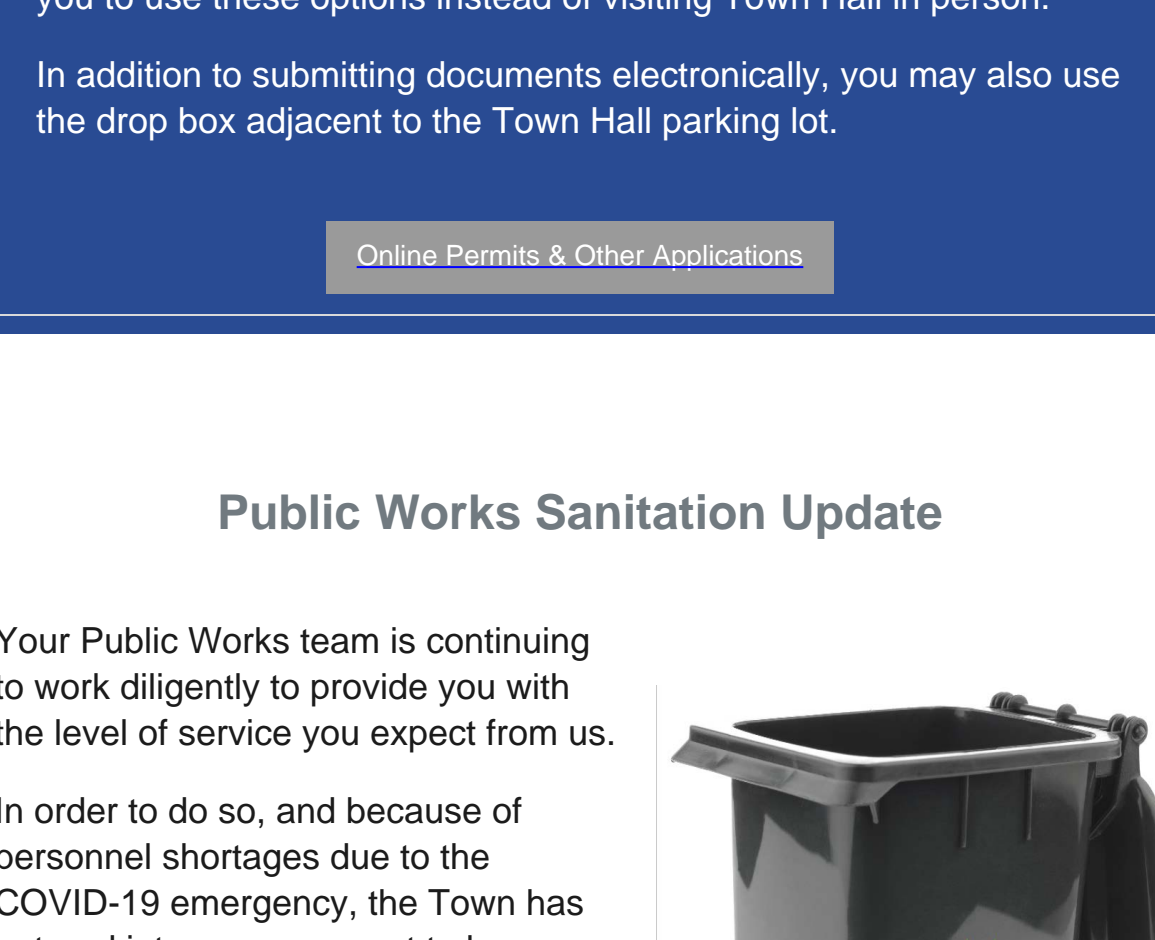

The Town of Lake Park provides many services either online or over the phone. For your safety and the safety of our Town staff, we urge you to use these options instead of visiting Town Hall in person.

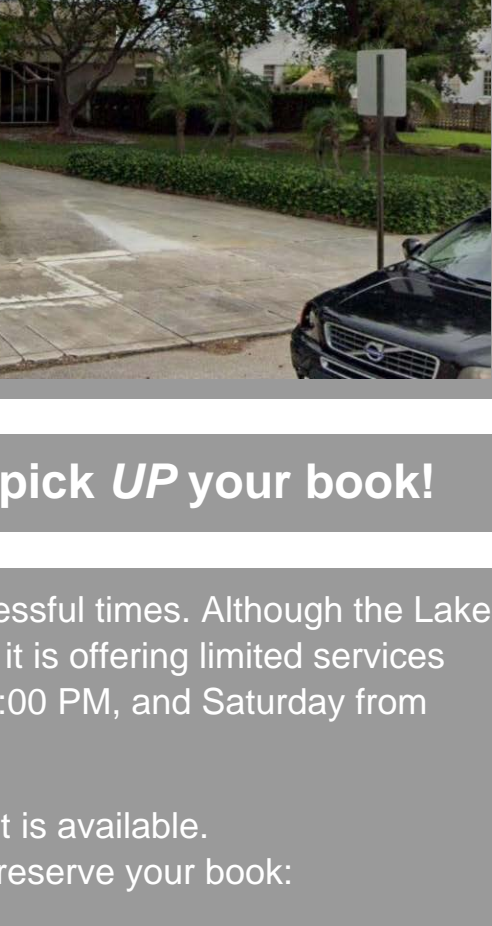

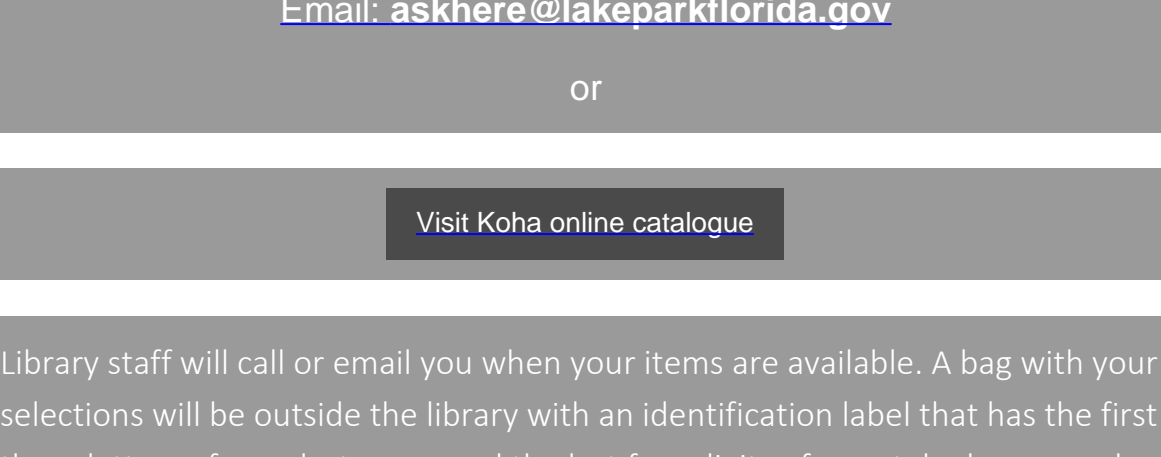
#### Public Works Sanitation Update

Your Public Works team is continuing to work diligently to provide you with the level of service you expect from us.

In order to do so, and because of personnel shortages due to the COVID-19 emergency, the Town has entered into an agreement to have Waste Management begin commercial dumpster collections immediately so that remaining Public Works personnel and resources can focus on residential sanitation operations including garbage, vegetation, bulk trash and recycling collections.



The Town is also working on an agreement to have Waste Management pick up residential recycling should that become necessary. Public Works expects to maintain the schedule below, and the Town will notify residents should any unexpected changes be required.



**Mondays:** Garbage can pickup

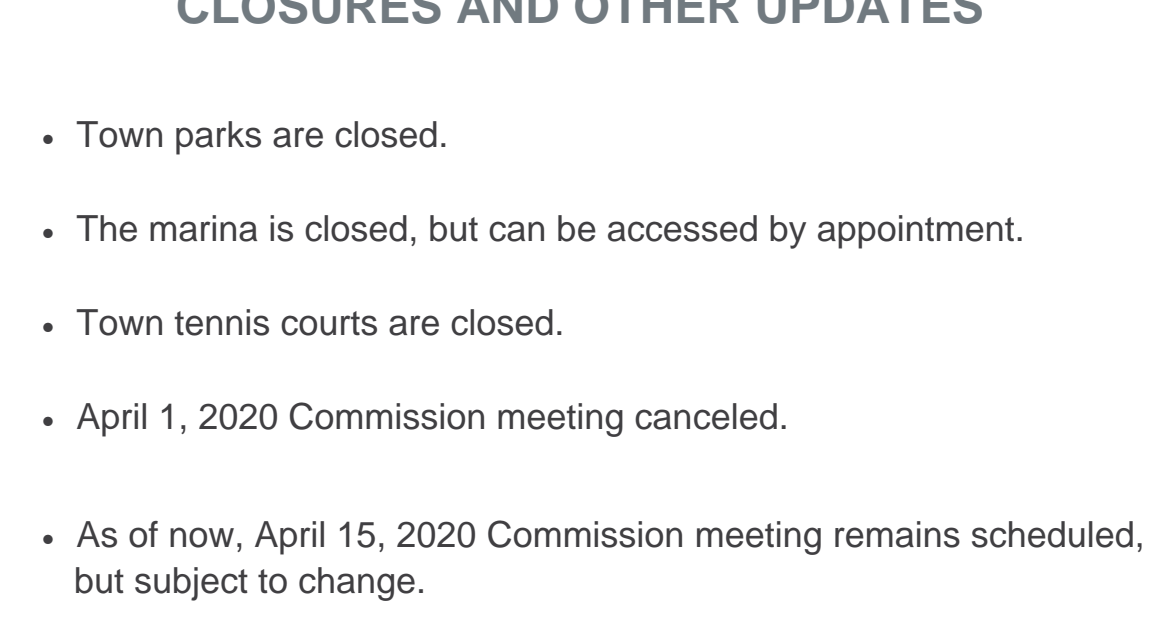
**Mondays and Tuesdays:** Vegetation pickup will begin on Monday and be completed on Tuesday

**Wednesdays:** Recycling pickup

**Thursdays:** Garbage can pickup

**Thursdays and Fridays:** Bulk trash pickup will begin on Thursday and be completed on Friday

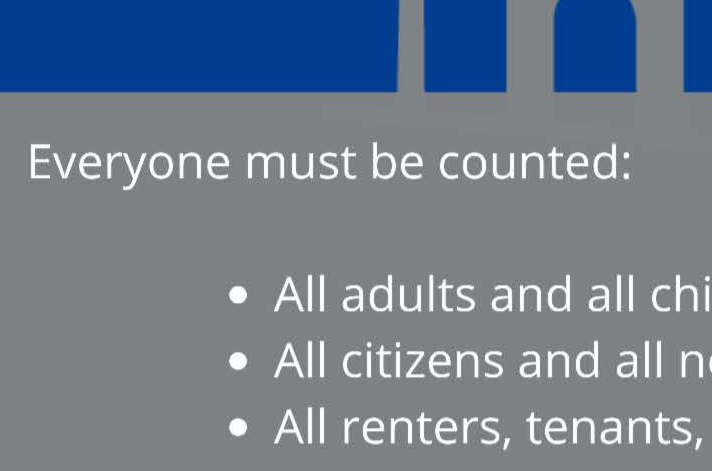

- April 1, 2020 Commission meeting canceled.

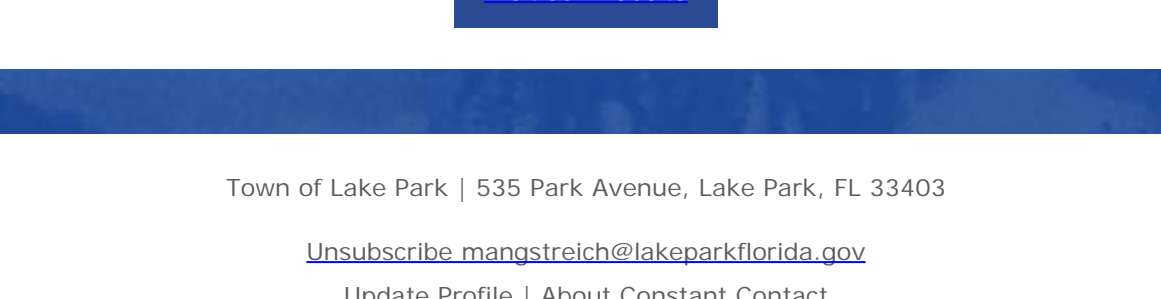
- As of now, April 15, 2020 Commission meeting remains scheduled, but subject to change.

#### April 1 is Census Day

Census Day is observed nationwide. By now you should have received your invitation to participate in the 2020 Census. If you have not already responded, you may respond in one of three ways: online, by phone, or by mail. When you respond to the census, you'll tell the Census Bureau where you live as of April 1, 2020.



Everyone must be counted:

- All adults and all children
- All citizens and all non-citizens
- All renters, tenants, and owners

The law ensures your private data is protected. Your answers cannot be used against you by any government agency or court.

The Census Bureau **cannot** release any personally identifiable information about you, your home, or your business, **even to law enforcement.**

You are kept anonymous. The Census Bureau is not permitted to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you or anyone else in your home.

You **will not** be asked about your citizenship.
