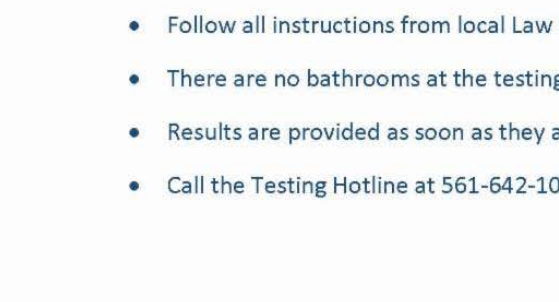

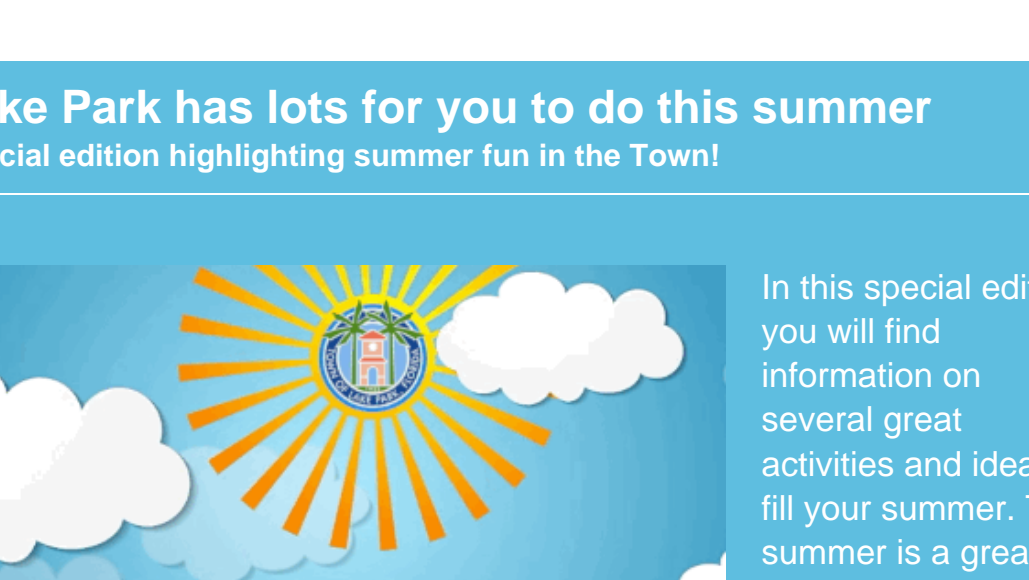


Free Coronavirus Testing

The Health Care District of Palm Beach County will be providing free coronavirus testing at Lake Park Town Hall during two days this month. The testing will be July 8 and July 16 from 9:00am to 4:00pm at Lake Park Town Hall, 535 Park Avenue.



COVID-19 Mobile Health Clinic Testing



Free COVID-19 testing is available to all Palm Beach County residents. Look for the Health Care District Mobile Health Clinics, Warrior and Scout, coming to your area.

- Free walk-up testing at our mobile clinics (there may be wait times)
- Bring a driver's license or photo ID
- Please wear a mask and practice social distancing if waiting
- Testing is open to all ages and you don't need to have symptoms to be tested
- A nasal swab test will be administered
- Follow all instructions from local Law Enforcement
- There are no bathrooms at the testing locations
- Results are provided as soon as they are available

The Lake Park Library is now open!

The Lake Park Library is open for visitors!
You are welcome to come in during the following hours:

- Monday through Thursday, 9:00am - 6:00pm
- Friday, 9:00am - 4:00pm
- Saturday, 10:00am - 4:00pm

Masks are required to enter. No one under the age of 14 will be permitted without a parent or guardian, and each parent/guardian may bring no more than two children at a time. All social distancing rules will be enforced. Use of the computer room will be limited to three people at a time (computer time may be limited depending upon demand). Curbside pickup is still available for those who prefer.

Masks required in public by Palm Beach County

Masks now required in public areas & public buildings

Palm Beach County is now enforcing more strict requirements regarding wearing masks. Here's what you need to know:

Mask is **REQUIRED** to enter all county and municipal buildings in Palm Beach County.

Mask is **REQUIRED** inside ANY building or business open to the public.

Mask is **REQUIRED** in public places where social distancing is not possible.

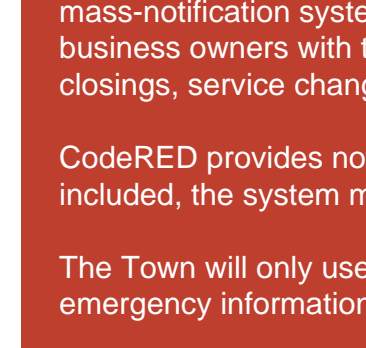
EXCEPTIONS

There are some exceptions to the requirement. They include:

- Children under two (2) years of age and any child while under the care of a licensed childcare facility, including daycares;
- Individuals while actively engaged in exercise and maintaining social distancing in accordance with CDC guidelines;
- Persons receiving goods or services from a business or establishment for the shortest practical period of time during which the receipt of such goods or services necessarily precludes the wearing of a facial covering such as, but not limited to, consuming food or beverage or receiving a facial grooming or treatment
- Persons who have a medical condition that makes the wearing of a facial covering unsafe such as, but not limited to, asthma, COPD, other conditions that reduce breathing or lung capacity;
- Persons for whom wearing a facial covering conflicts with their religious beliefs or practices;
- Facial coverings may be removed temporarily while assisting persons who are hearing impaired or who rely on reading lips in order to communicate.

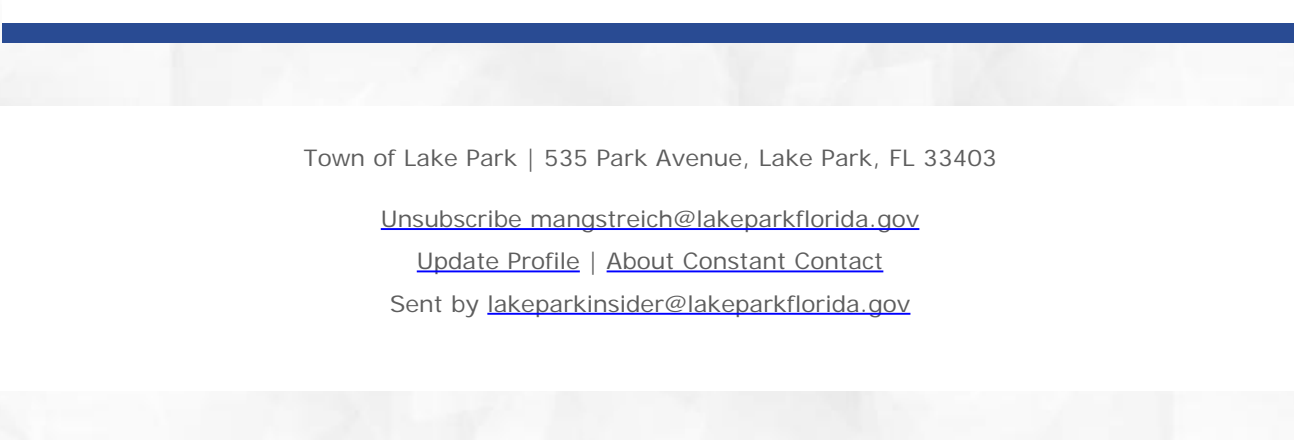

The Town of Lake Park is pleased to announce that we will soon begin using a mass-notification system called CodeRED to provide Lake Park residents and business owners with timely information regarding emergencies, office closings, service changes, and more.

CodeRED provides notifications via text or voice messages. In order to be included, the system must have your cell phone number.

The Town will only use your information for the purposes of public notifications, emergency information, or other government-related purposes.
