One of the questions on the March ballot will be whether the town should

continue an economic development tool that has been in place for a decade.

Tax incentive programs offer reductions in property taxes to businesses that move to the town, add to the local economy, or create new local jobs. Before

any tax break is granted, a business needs to meet a specific set of qualifications and criteria. Voters must grant permission every ten years for the Town to be able to offer such tax incentives, and this March is the renewal.

The ballot question reads:


