

Do you have a project or program that will benefit Lake Park's residents? If so,

you may be eligible for grant funding from the Town. Under the Small Grant Program, individuals who reside in the Town may request up to a total of \$500. The Large Grant Program, which is available to groups, corporate entities, not-for-profit organizations, etc. that are based in the Town requires a 100% match by the applicant, which means applicants may

request up to 50% of the total monetary cost of the project (up to \$20,000) and must provide the other 50% via allowable matches. Those applying under the
