## REDUCE CRIME IN LAKE PARK





Safety has steadily increased in Lake Park over the last several years. Crimes

included:

- such as personal robbery, sexual assault, shootings and residential burglaries have all dropped over 60% since 2017, and nearly all other crimes have seen




