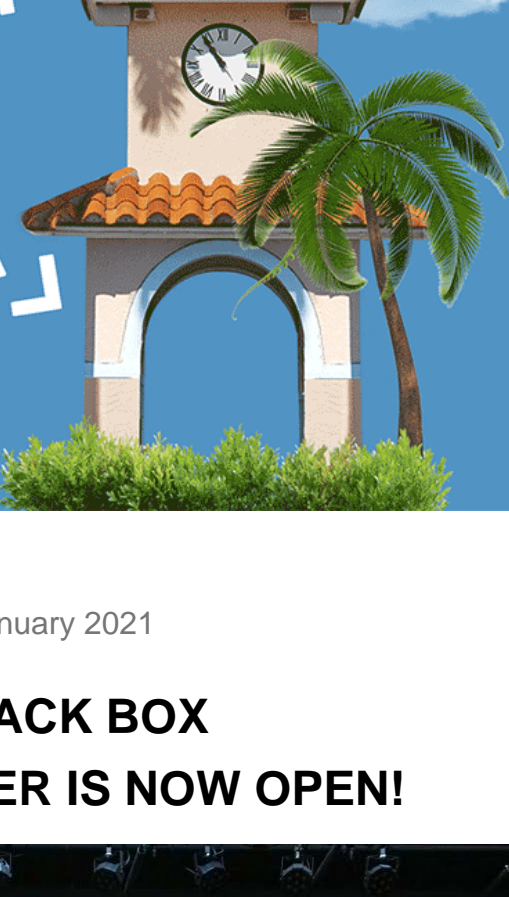
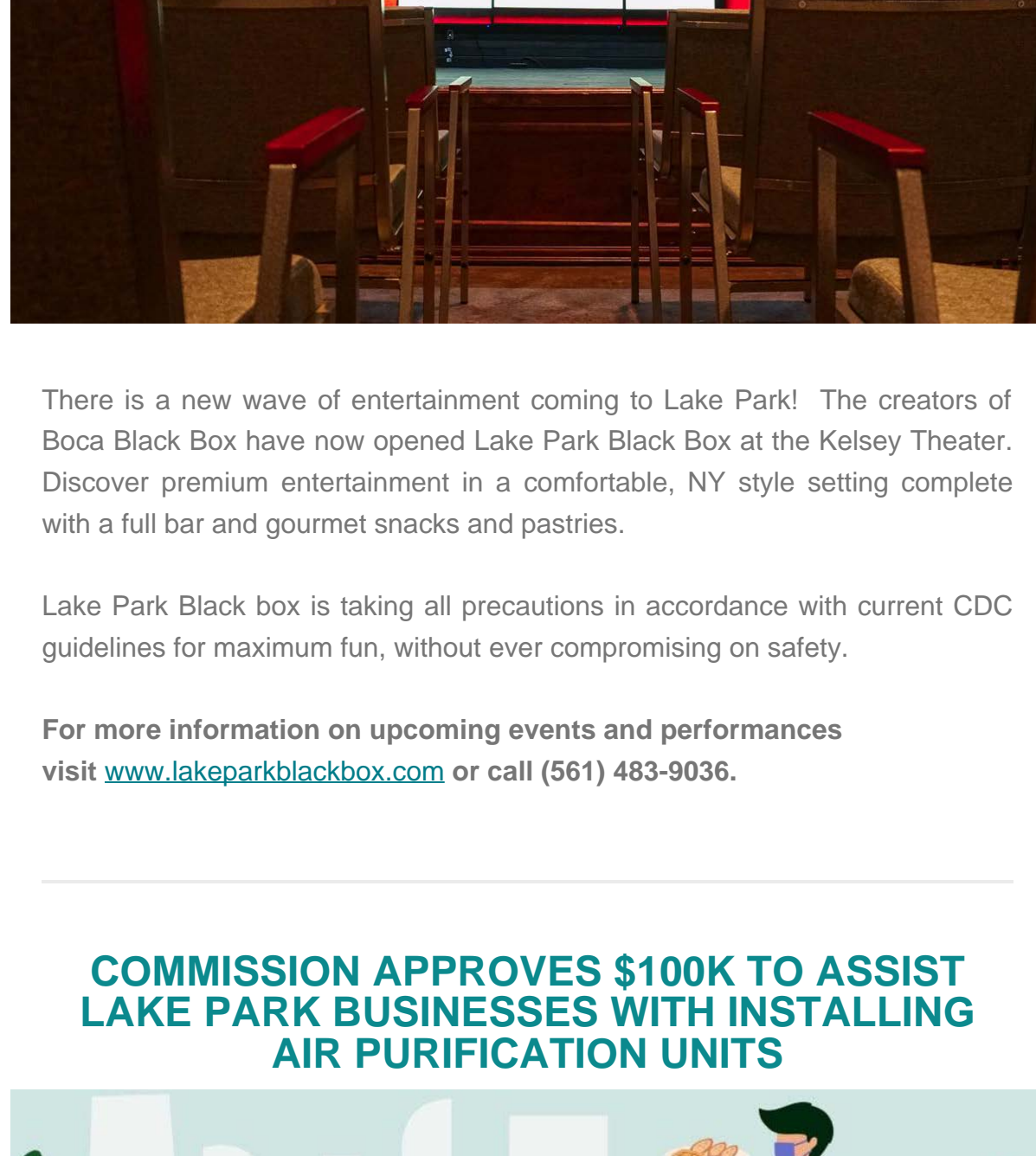

COMMISSION APPROVES \$100K TO ASSIST LAKE PARK BUSINESSES WITH INSTALLING AIR PURIFICATION UNITS



The Town of Lake Park understands the importance of safety as we navigate this pandemic that has affected our communities and businesses. In an effort to provide an environmental response that will help patrons to feel safe returning to the Town's vital dining and entertainment establishments, the Lake Park Town Commission has allocated \$100,000 to assist Lake Park restaurants, microbreweries and indoor entertainment venues to install REME HALO® and Commercial PHI air purification units. These units are installed in the air handlers of the air conditioning units in establishments. Funds will be provided to support half the cost (50%) of the purchase and installation, up to \$1,000 per unit, of up to 10 air handlers per business. Funding – which will be provided based upon an inspection of the installed equipment – is available on a first-come, first-served basis until the \$100,000 is exhausted.

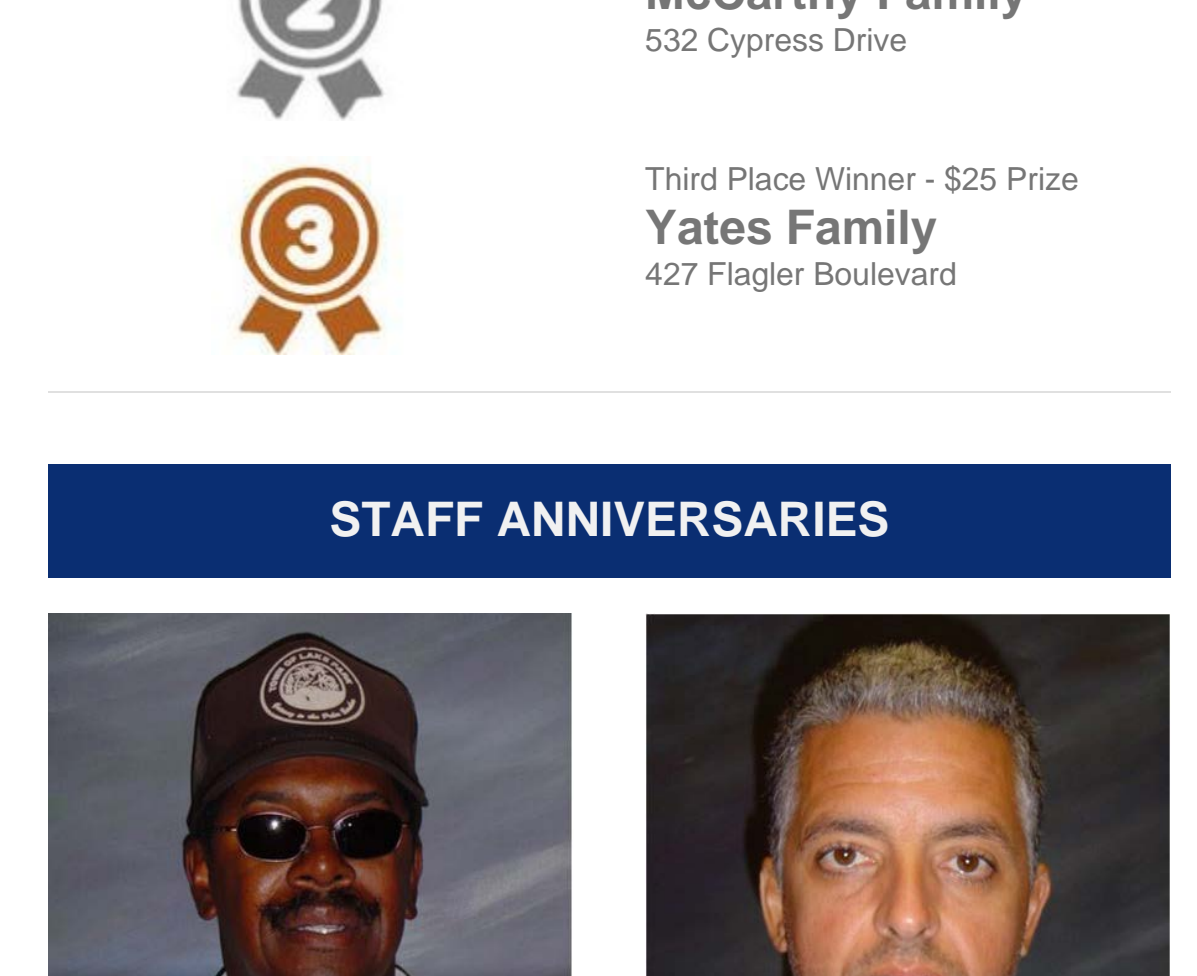
SKYVIEW CCTVS AID PBSO WITH LOCATING HIT-AND-RUN DRIVERS



PBSO responded to a hit-and-run in Lake Park on December 16 that left a pedestrian with severe facial injuries and a broken leg. After officers arrived promptly on the scene, they quickly turned to the Town's SkyView CCTVs and License Plate Readers to investigate leads. They were able to track down and locate the suspect at Legacy Place in Palm Beach Gardens. The suspect confessed to being the driver and was arrested.

License Plate Readers and SkyView cameras are located throughout Lake Park in an effort to improve police responsiveness and improve Town safety. These are just some of the many tools PBSO employs that led to a 19% decrease in crime in Lake Park between 2016 and 2019.
