LAKE PARK IS CONSIDERING ALLOWING ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS...WHAT ARE THEY AND WHAT DO THEY MEAN TO YOU?



An **Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU)** is a second residential unit on your single-family property that is separate from your main home. It can be an apartment located in your primary home, it can be a separate unit attached to the main house, or freestanding on the property. Regardless of where it is located, an ADU must be a complete, self-contained residence that has places for sleeping, bathing, and eating that are separate from the main home. There are already more than 50 ADUs in the Town, all of which were built decades ago.

The Town of Lake Park is currently considering changing our zoning codes to once again allow for ADUs.
