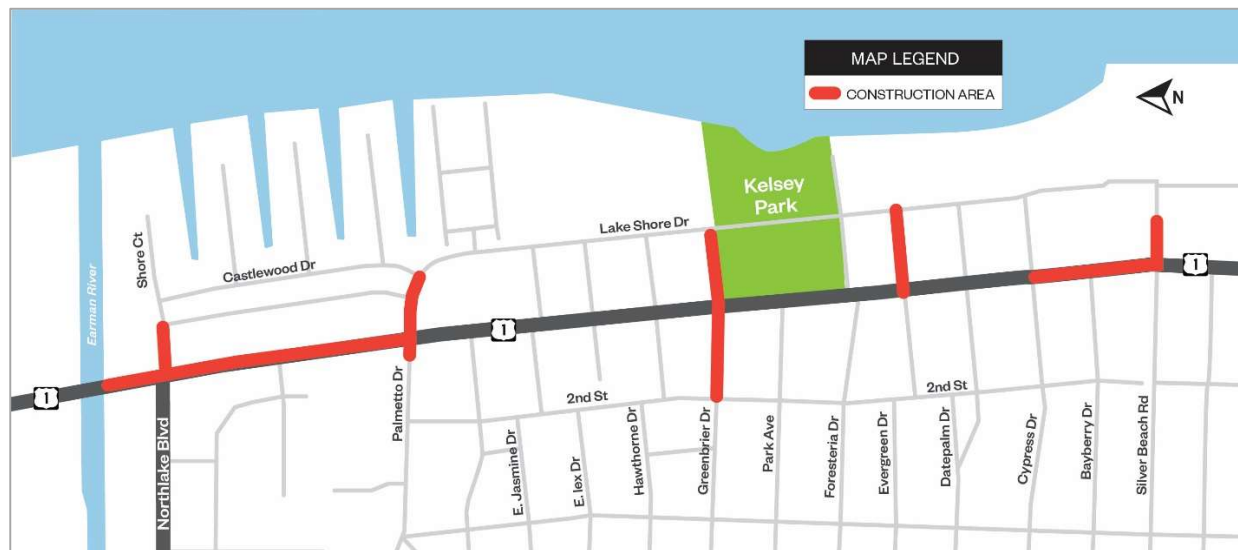
US-1 SOUTH WATER AND SEWER FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

General Project Information

Seacoast Utility Authority will be upgrading the water and sewer infrastructure along US-1 from Silver Beach Road on the south to the Earman River on the north. Work on-site is scheduled to begin in February 2023 and will last approximately 8 months.

The existing infrastructure is nearing the end of its useful life. Consequently, this work is necessary to enhance the reliability and sustainability of this infrastructure. The proposed improvements will help ensure the anticipated redevelopment of the US-1 corridor will not adversely impact existing water and sewer service.

The construction area is indicated in the map below. Roads will remain accessible but with reduced traffic capacity; expect periodic lane closures. Neighbors will be able to access business and properties during construction. Please follow posted detour signs and drive with caution in the area.



Temporary (short-duration) water and sewer service disruptions will be required during certain phases of construction. Our neighbors will be notified individually in advance of planned outages. We appreciate your patience.
