



The Town was able to undertake this year-long project thanks to \$95,655 in Community Development Block Grant funds and a generous \$40,000 donation from Forest Development (the developers of Nautilus 220), while the bulk of the funding was taken from the Town's Public Improvement Fund (derived from the \$1.8 million provided by Forest Development as part of a requirement for all new projects proposed within the US 1 mixed-use corridor; the \$1.8 million amount represents 1% of the value of the Nautilus 220 construction costs). The Town marked the completion of this community-improvement project in

December with a ribbon-cutting ceremony attended by Peter Baytarian and
