

for Hickard **MAYOR SUMMER SAFETY TIPS**

Here are some tips that are easy to follow and may help save your life or the life of a loved one. South Florida's extreme summer heat can cause illness, dehydration, and even death. While this can be dangerous for everyone, children, senior citizens, and those who play outdoor sports during the summer months are at the greatest risk for heat-related illnesses. It is important to learn the signs and symptoms of extreme heat exposure and how to remedy them. • NEVER leave children unattended or unsupervised in parked cars. Leaving a child alone in a car can lead to serious injury or death from • Drink plenty of liquids, regardless of your activity level. • Wear lightweight clothing that is light-colored and breathable.
