

RESOLUTION NO. 31-11-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, REVISING THE CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE TOWN CLASSIFIED SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF AN UPDATED "CLASSIFICATION PLAN MANUAL".

WHEREAS, section 2-151 (1) of the Town Code provides for the preparation, maintenance, and revision of a position classification plan for all positions in Town service; and

WHEREAS, the Classification Plan is based upon similarity of duties performed and responsibilities assumed, so that the same qualifications are reasonably required for the same schedule of pay and equally applied to all positions in the same class; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide an updated listing of certain current titles and classifications within the Town services,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The whereas clauses are true and correct and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The classification Plan Manual is revised to contain the newly created position of **HARBOR MARINA MANAGER**, which position becomes part of the Classification Plan of the Town of Lake Park.

SECTION 3. Delete the title Business Manager/Marina from the Town of Lake Park Classification Manual.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
