RESOLUTION NO. 05-01-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN, TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, PALM BEACH COUNTY, THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PALM BEACH, AND THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS; AND TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK'S WITHDRAWAL FROM THE AGREEMENT; FOR THE PURPOSE OF EFFECTUATING THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK FROM THE AGREEMENT AND THE NORTHLAKE TASK FORCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Park (Town), Palm Beach County ("County"), the Village of North Palm Beach ("Village"), and the City of Palm Beach Gardens (City), all exercise zoning authority over properties within their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, F.S., authorizes and encourages local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate in the provision of services and facilities; and

WHEREAS, in or about September 3, 1997, the Town entered into an Inter-local Agreement ("Agreement") with the County, Village and City

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides, among other things, for heightened review of development of unincorporated lands located along Northlake Boulevard between Military Trail and U.S. Highway One, and approving the Northlake Boulevard Overlay Zoning District (NBOZ) design guidelines as a policy and growth management guide; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Park Commission has determined that it is no longer in the best interests of the Town to remain a party to this Agreement or to remain a member of the Northlake Boulevard Task Force ("Task Force"); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Park wishes to provide notice of its intent to withdraw as a party to the Agreement, and from the Task Force, to the remaining parties to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, at the Lake Park Commission meeting of December 17, 2003, the Lake Park Commission voted to withdraw from the Agreement and the Northlake Boulevard Task Force, and to take all other actions necessary and incidental thereto; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to authorize and direct the Mayor to take such actions as may be necessary to effectuate the Town's withdrawal from the Agreement and the from the Northlake Boulevard Task Force; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK:

Section 1.

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute written correspondence on behalf of the Town, giving notice to the County, Village and the City of the Town of Lake Park's withdrawal from the Agreement, and to execute such amendments to the Inter-local Agreement as may be necessary for the Town to terminate it participation in the Northlake Boulevard Task Force.

Section 2.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing RESOLUTION was offered by Commissioner Longtiwho moved adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Balius and upon being put to a vote, the results were as follows:
