

RESOLUTION NO. 66-11-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK AND DAVCO ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS CORP. SUPPLY INC. TO INSTALL THEATRICAL LIGHTING AND SOUND SYSTEM CONDUIT IN THE MIRROR BALLROOM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Park (“Town”) is a municipal corporation of the State of Florida with such power and authority as has been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town having received a grant to renovate the Mirror Ballroom; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission agrees to enter into an Agreement with Davco Electrical Contractors Corp to supply the Theatrical Lighting and the Sound System Conduit as part of the renovation of the Mirror Ballroom.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK:

SECTION 1.

The whereas clauses are hereby incorporated herein as true and correct.

SECTION 2.

That the Town Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement, subject to the approval of the agreement by the Town Attorney, for the Theatrical Lighting and Sound System Conduit that will be supplied by Davco Electrical Contractors Corp.

SECTION 3.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
