

RESOLUTION NO. 37-08-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE CERTIFICATION AND ADOPTION OF A SANITATION ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1, Florida Constitution (1968), and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the Town Commission of the Town of Lake Park, Florida (Town) has all powers of local self-government to perform municipal functions and to render municipal services in a manner not inconsistent with general or special law, and such power may be exercised by the enactment of municipal ordinances;

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town has adopted Resolution No. 34-08-09 setting the rates for sanitation assessments for Fiscal Year 2009-2010: and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town has found that owners, tenants and occupants of property within the geographical boundaries of the Town will derive a special benefit from the sanitation assessments and from the operation and maintenance of the Sanitation Fund; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this resolution certifying a sanitation assessment roll was duly noticed and held;

WHEREAS, the owner of each parcel within the benefited area for which a sanitation assessment is levied shall thereafter be responsible for payment therefore.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Commission of the Town of Lake Park, Florida:

Section 1. Legislative Intent. The foregoing whereas clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. Adoption of Assessment Roll. The Town Commission hereby adopts and certifies the Sanitation Assessment Roll, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Town Clerk..

Section 3. Effective date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Commissioner Rumsey who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Carey, and upon being put to a roll call vote, the vote was as follows:
