A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO FUEL CONTROL READER INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH PALM BEACH COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Park (Town) is a municipal corporation of the State of Florida with such power and authority as has been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, section 163.01, F.S. permits local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with one another on a basis of mutual advantage by providing services and facilities that will be mutually beneficial to the local communities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 163.01, F.S., the Town has previously entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County (County) to have a fuel pump control reader installed and maintained by the County and interfaced with the County's fleet management computer; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement with the County will expire on January 8, 2012; and WHEREAS, the County and Town have agreed to amend and extend the Interlocal Agreement through January 8, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to extend the Interlocal Agreement with the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK:

## **SECTION 1.**

The whereas clauses are hereby incorporated herein and are true and correct.

## **SECTION 2.**

The Mayor is hereby directed and authorized to execute the First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement, extending it to January 8, 2017.

## **SECTION 3.**

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

#### FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Town agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement expires on January 8, 2012, and shall be extended to January 8, 2017.
- 2. Section 3.01 of the Agreement is amended to reflect the following address for the County's Fleet Management administrative office:

2601 Vista Parkway West Palm Beach, FL 33411

- 3. Section 4 of the Agreement is amended to delete the SECTION 4 heading "EQUIPMENT TO BE PURCHASED BY TOWN" and to replace it as follows: EQUIPMENT PURCHASED BY THE TOWN.
- 4. Section 4.01 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:
  - 4.01. The Town owns one (1) E.J. Ward Fuel Control Reader, including key pad, card reader and software (the "Equipment") that interfaces with the County's Fleet Management computer.
- 5. Section 4.02 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:
  - 4.02. The Equipment is located adjacent to the fuel pumps located at 650 Old Dixie Highway, Lake Park, Florida and was installed at the Town's sole cost. The Town shall provide, at its expense, a dedicated telephone line for the Equipment to connect with the County's Fleet Management computer and all electricity needed to operate the Equipment. The Town shall not relocate, alter, or tie into the Equipment without prior written approval from the County.
- 6. Section 5.02 of the Agreement is amended to delete the reference to Section 5.07 and to replace it with Section 6.07.
- 7. Section 6.01 of the Agreement is amended to replace the Attachment 1 attached to the Agreement with Attachment 1 attached to this First Amendment and made a part hereof.
- 8. Section 15 of the Agreement is amended as to the County, to:

9. The Agreement is hereby amended to add Section 22 as follows:

### SECTION 22: OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL

22.01 Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General. The Inspector General's authority includes but is not limited to the power to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records, to require the production of records, and audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of the parties or entities with which the County enters into agreements, their officers, agents, employees, and lobbyists in order to ensure compliance with contract specifications and detect corruption and fraud. All parties or entities doing business with the County or receiving County funds shall fully cooperate with the Inspector General including granting the Inspector General access to records relating to the agreement and transaction.

10. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains unmodified and in full force and effect in accordance with the terms thereof.
