

ORDINANCE NO. 15-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE III, OF THE TOWN CODE ENTITLED "PARK REGULATIONS"; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 18-63 TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 18-63; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Park, Florida ("Town") is a duly constituted municipality having such power and authority conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission has previously adopted hours of operation pertaining to Town parks; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office has requested that the Town provide for penalties for those persons violating the provisions contained in Chapter 18, Article III, Section 18-63; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission, has determined that the amendment to Chapter 18, Article III, Section 18-63 of the Town Code as recommended by the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office would further the public health, safety and general welfare by allowing for additional enforcement of park hours.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The whereas clauses are hereby incorporated as true and correct findings of fact of the Town Commission.

Section 2. Section 18-63 is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 18-63. Hours of operation for town parks; penalties.

(a) *Generally.* All town parks, excluding the marina, shall be open each day from 6:30 a.m.—10:00 p.m., every day of the year. The only exception are areas that have been granted a special event permit or facility rental agreement by the town.

(b) *Closing hours.* The hours of town parks shall be clearly posted at all town parks.

(c) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding sixty (60) days, or by both.

Section 3. **Severability.** If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held by a Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. **Repeal of Laws in Conflict.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Codification.** The provision of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Lake Park. The Sections of the Ordinance maybe renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such.

Section 6. **Effective date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon execution.

Upon First Reading this 5 day of December, 2018, the foregoing Ordinance was offered by Commissioner Michaud who moved its approval. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lynch and being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




