**PRESENTATION:**

Presentation by Captain Reece, Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, provided the Commission answers to their concerns from the previous meeting. Captain Reece provided the Town with a monthly report, (see Exhibit "A"). Captain Reece stated that the deputies investigate burglaries aggressively, collect fingerprints and Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) from crime scenes; deputies are performing proactive activities that lead to potential arrests. Captain Reece stated that deputies' cell phone uses are often legitimate although occasionally some personal calls are made. Supervisors have advised notified to monitor the use. Captain Reece stated that twenty (20) deputies are assigned to Lake Park, which could explain why different deputies are spotted throughout Town, and not the

same familiar faces. Captain Reece explained that almost all the vehicles are now marked with the Town of Lake Park decals, the remaining vehicles will be completed as more decals arrive. Captain Reece invited the Commission to come out and spend an evening with the deputies to experience a night on the road with them. Mayor Castro thanked Captain Reece for the report and indicated that he would like to ride with the deputies over the New Year's weekend. Captain Reece stated that he would make those arrangements.

**PUBLIC and OTHER COMMENT**

The following person(s) addressed the Commission:

*Dr. Sallent, 500 Federal Highway* – Dr. Sallent stated his anticipation to occupy the Pediatric Respiratory Center for mid January, but is not clear to what process he needs to take to proceed. Mayor Castro instructed Dr. Sallent to meet with Jamie Gentile of Calvin Giordano in the Community Development Department for further direction.

Dr. Sallent expressed his concern with a consultant bill he received from the Town. Mayor Castro explained that the bill is a cost recovery fee for services that have been rendered by the Town's consultant.

*Roselyn Giordano, 211 E. Ilex Drive* – Expressed the need to have a Valentine's Day Family Picnic and Parade for the children. Ms. Giordano submitted a letter for the Mayor through the Town Clerk, see "Exhibit B".

*Bert Bostrum, 1451 Flagler Blvd.* - Expressed her concern with a Commissioner not being a resident of the Town and opined that the Commissioner should resign.



Listed below is the monthly activity from District 10 during the month of November 2005. Additionally, please find an attachment documenting activity and personnel hours expended for the newly opened Target at 500 N. Congress Ave.

**Notable Activity/Arrests:**

- 11/2/05 @ 2042 hrs – Cpl. Davis conducted a traffic stop at Northlake Blvd. and 10<sup>th</sup> St. The driver was found to have an active warrant and was arrested. During a search of the vehicle a drug pipe was also discovered. The arrestee was charged with failure to appear and possession of drug paraphernalia.
- 11/2/05 @ 0330 hrs – Deputy Gray stopped a subject riding a bicycle at night with no lights at 1107 Old Dixie Hwy. A computer check revealed the subject had an active failure to appear warrant for traffic. The subject was arrested and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.
- 11/3/05 @ 0005 hrs – Deputy Mangold conducted a traffic stop on a 1985 Ford pickup at 1107 Old Dixie Hwy. - 11/4/05 @ 0200 hrs – Deputy Mangold conducted a traffic stop at 815 Venetian Isles Dr. During the traffic stop Deputy Mangold observed in plain view a bag containing cocaine on the center console of the vehicle. A search incident to arrest also found marijuana under the seat.
- 11/4/05 @ 1930 hrs – Deputy Cullen assisted Palm Beach Gardens Police Department by conducting a traffic stop on a vehicle in the parking lot of the K-Mart at 1220 Northlake Blvd. The driver was arrested for habitual driving while license suspended. A search was conducted incident to the arrest and approximately 10 grams of cocaine and approximately 5 grams of marijuana was found in addition to three drug pipes. The driver was arrested and transported to the Palm Beach County jail.
- 11/5/05 @ 0120 hrs – Approximately two weeks prior to this date, the property owner at 218 7<sup>th</sup> St contacted PBSO and made a complaint indicating unknown persons were lodging inside the vacant apartments which were under construction. Deputy Cullen worked with the property owner who signed a trespass affidavit for the above-mentioned apartments to post the property and set up directed patrols. Deputies Cullen and Bufano discovered a subject trespassing in one of the apartments and arrested him.
- 11/8/05 @ 2010 hrs – Deputy Turpin conducted a traffic stop at 800 Silver Beach Rd. The driver was found to have no valid driver's license. A search was conducted incident to arrest and a Crazy Glue container fell from the arrestee's pants. Inside the container was crack cocaine. Driver arrested and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.
- 11/10/05 @ 1515 hrs – Cpl. Scerbo arrested a subject for possession of a stolen in the 500 block of Northlake Blvd.
- 11/12/05 – Deputy Bufano at the request of the Town Manager conducted a survey of the town to document the inoperative streetlights. The survey was completed and turned over to the Town manager.
