#### **PUBLIC and OTHER COMMENT**

The following person(s) addressed the Commission:

*Trudy Gomez, 546 Foresteria Dr.* – Ms. Gomez stated that she previously addressed the Commission on April 5, 2006 regarding a Notice of Hearing she received for planting palm trees in her swale area. Ms. Gomez reviewed her comments and questions of her presentation at the April 5, 2006 Commission meeting. Ms. Gomez stated that she spoke with Vivian Mendez, Town Clerk, and Paul Carlisle, Town Manager on the status of the trees in swales ordinance being placed on the agenda and was told that it should be placed on the agenda soon. Ms. Gomez addressed the Commission and inquired of the status of the trees in swales ordinance.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle explained that the swale ordinance is voluminous and staff tried to trim the ordinance down to pertain to just palm trees. He stated that staff did not recommend the ordinance be trimmed but that the Commission had directed them to do so. Town Manager Paul Carlisle asked the Commission for direction on the swale ordinance.

Mayor Castro recommended that the swale ordinance be brought back for discussion. Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that they will bring back the swale ordinance for discussion to the next Commission meeting in July. Mayor Castro agreed and stated that the ordinance will be discussed at the next Commission meeting on July 5, 2006 and will direct staff to make any changes that Commission feels would be appropriate at that time. Mayor Castro stated that staff concluded from their research that there are no other municipalities that allow vegetation in the swales. Mayor Castro stated that the City of Palm Beach allows vegetation in the swales on a very limited basis.

Ms. Gomez gave a history of the code violation case on her property. Mayor Castro reminded Ms. Gomez that her code violation was discussed previously. Mayor Castro asked Ms. Gomez to return to the next Commission meeting on July 5, 2006 as they will discuss the swale ordinance. Commissioner Balius asked Ms. Gomez if she was cited and had removed her trees. Ms. Gomez stated that she was cited and had to remove her trees. Commissioner Balius stated that he believed the Commission agreed to stop citing residents for trees in swales until they discussed the ordinance. Mayor Castro stated that the Town has had a couple of code enforcement officers and town managers since that discussion. Commissioner Balius stated that that was not an excuse.

Commissioner Osterman stated that a friend that lived in North Palm Beach had a Maleluca tree removed from her swale and was given a choice of a replacement tree. Commissioner Osterman stated that there are many different issues regarding the swale ordinance and is hopeful that a compromise could be reached.

*Bert Bostrum, 1451 Flagler Blvd.* – stated that she would like to make a correction on the phone number that was placed in the Town paper. The number in the paper was 842-2523. The correct phone number is 842-2524.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE LAKE PARK TOWN CODE, CHAPTER 78, ARTICLE II, SECTION 78-31 ENTITLED “DIVISION OF TOWN INTO**

**ORDINANCE NO. 06-2006 – Prohibited Parking**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, CHAPTER 30, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES", ARTICLE I, "IN GENERAL", SECTION 30-2 ENTITLED "PROHIBITED PARKING"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Commissioner Carey asked if tickets will be written for prohibited parking on Park Ave.

Mayor Castro stated he would like to write warnings first before writing tickets.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that there are no warnings posted on Park Ave because it is a three (3) lane street. He recommended that residents be made aware that parking on Park Ave is prohibited.

Mayor Castro asked if the Planner I position was being added or revised.

Mayor Castro stated that in past discussions he did not want to add the Planner I position to the Community Development Department.

Commissioner Balius asked if the Planner I position will address the permit processing complaints

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION**

**To join Municipal Underground Utilities Consortium for Underground Utilities**

Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that the Town's cost or consortium would be \$1,407.00 and explained the study which justifies placing overhead lines underground in various municipalities in Palm Beach County. He explained that FPL provided a report that overestimates and do not accurately account the cost for the overhead lines. Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that the report overestimates the cost of the buried lines and underestimates the cost of overhead lines. He explained that the study is an independent study to balance out the cost of the underground utilities.

**TelVue Virtual Television Network**

Town Manager Paul Carlisle explained what the network provides and commented that it will benefit the Town. He introduced Ms. Elizabeth Nelson from Virtual Television Network.

Ms. Nelson from Virtual Television Network gave a presentation of the network and explained the benefits to the Town.

Commissioner Balius asked what the cost of the network would be.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle explained that the network is free. He stated that the network will sell the advertisements which value at \$12,000.00. He explained that there is a \$12,000.00 set up fee and a cost of \$500.00 per month which will be paid by the advertisements.

Ms. Nelson explained that they are not advertisements but sponsorships.

Commissioner Carey asked if the network will do the legwork in obtaining sponsorship.

Ms. Nelson explained the types of contracts and what would occur if there was not enough sponsorship. She explained a contract would be guaranteed for two (2) years.

Commissioner Carey stated that he saw the network at the League of Cities last year and approved of having the new network.

## COMMENTS BY COMMISSION, TOWN MANAGER, TOWN ATTORNEY

### **Commissioner Balius**

Commissioner Balius stated that he received several complaints of boulders in swales.

Commissioner Balius stated that the people that did attend the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Meet & Greet presented very good questions.

Commissioner Balius expressed concern over distribution lines running in front and behind his house.

Commissioner Balius stated that misprints in the Town newsletter has happened in the past.

Commissioner Balius commented on Quality Cities Magazine and stated that in the past, Bambi McKibbon-Turner, Personnel Director was able to have an article run in the magazine about Lake Park.

Commissioner Balius suggested that Bambi McKibbon-Turner, Personnel Director run an article regarding the Lake Park Harbor Marina in the Quality Cities Magazine.

### **Mayor Castro**

Mayor Castro recommended that the Town make a code enforcement complaint with Palm Beach County regarding boulders in the swales.

Mayor Castro agreed with Cynthia Sementelli, Interim Town Manager that it would be in the Town's best interest to keep Paul Carlisle, Town Manager as consultant and he expressed that the transition needed to be as smooth as possible.

Mayor Castro recommended that the Commission write a letter to the Sheriff expressing thanks for coming back to the Town of Lake Park.

Mayor Castro expressed concern over essential services such as power distribution centers and specifically the distribution center on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Mayor Castro stated that as Riviera Beach grows, there will be expansion. Mayor Castro expressed concern that the Town will have to pay for Riviera Beach's developments. Mayor Castro stated that there will be heavy distribution lines running up 2<sup>nd</sup> St. and US 1 and recommended that the lines be buried. Mayor Castro stated that he heard that Riviera Beach did not want their distribution center in their city but in Lake Park. Mayor Castro stated that it is the Town Manager's decision as to whether to use a third party in proofreading the Town newsletter. Mayor Castro commented that of all phone numbers to be printed in the Town newsletter, Bert Bostrum's phone number should have had special attention. Mayor Castro addressed the Commission and citizens of Lake Park and stated that they not call him after 9 pm or before 7 am.

Mayor Castro agreed with Commissioner Balius' idea to have Bambi McKibbon-Turner, Personnel Director run an ad about the Lake Park Harbor Marina in the Quality Cities Magazine. Mayor Castro announced the Town of Lake Park Firework Festival and stated that it is taking place on July 1, 2006 between 4:30 pm to 10 pm.

### **Commissioner Osterman**

Commissioner Osterman stated that the people that attended the PBSO Meet & Greet had very good suggestions. Commissioner Osterman expressed thanks and gratitude to the people who attended the PBSO Meet & Greet. Commissioner Osterman stated that the Sheriff was open to suggestions.

Commissioner Osterman asked Town Manager Paul Carlisle if a stipend or bonus for Bambi McKibbon-Turner, Personnel Director will be discussed.

Commissioner Osterman asked Town Manager Paul Carlisle for the status on the Commission's e-mail communication and stated that she was still receiving complaints.

Commissioner Osterman expressed concern over the Town newsletter. Commissioner Osterman stated that there are more fillers than articles in the Town newsletter. Commissioner Osterman expressed concern over the misprint of Bert Bostrum's phone number in the Town newsletter. Commissioner Osterman asked what can be done to change perception of a Town employee who has had issues of misconduct in the past. Commissioner Osterman stated that certain phone numbers should be double checked when proofreading the Town newsletter.

#### **Vice-Mayor Daly**

Vice Mayor Daly asked the Commission if they would be interested in setting up a consulting fee for Town Manager Paul Carlisle to follow up on projects for the Town.

Vice-Mayor Daly expressed his disappointment and embarrassment with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Meet & Greet. He stated that the Sheriff, sergeants, and captains showed up but citizens and residents did not. Vice-Mayor Daly stated that Captain Reese works very hard for the Town.

Vice-Mayor Daly recommended that a second or third party neutral person review the Town newsletter before it is distributed.

#### **Town Attorney**

#### **Town Manager**

Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that he passed the information he received from Mayor Castro on Florida Statutes relating to power distribution centers to Attorney Thomas Baird. Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that Attorney Thomas Baird will review the information on power distribution centers.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that he discussed the Commission's e-mail issues with Hoa Huang, Assistant to Town Manager and that he stated that he will remove the features that are causing the complications.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that he cannot change the perception of the Commission or Community concerning the past misconduct of an employee of the Town. Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that he does not believe that a town employee sabotaged the Town newsletter by misprinting one digit in Bert Bostrum's phone number. Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that he reviews the Town newsletter for content and does not know everyone's phone number thus making it difficult for him to determine whether a number has been misprinted. Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that some people like the fillers that are in the Town newsletter.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle stated that Bambi McKibbon-Turner, Personnel Director is in the process of reviewing and scoring/ranking applications for a new town manager.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle recommended a 20% salary increase be given to Bambi, Personnel Director for searching for a new town manager.

Town Manager Paul Carlisle informed the Commission of the Health Fair and Blood Drive taking place at Town Hall on June 27, 2006 between 10 am and 3 pm.

#### **Cynthia Sementelli, Interim Town Manager**

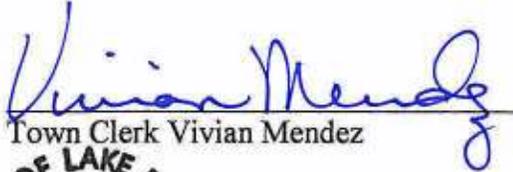

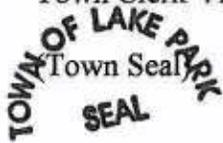
