NEW BUSINESS:

➤ Discussion about revising the Lake Park, Florida Code of Ordinances concerning the Library Board.

The Members agreed that the ordinance should remain unchanged except for Section 2-158 which concerns the number of meetings to be held. The suggestion was made to hold regular meetings quarterly rather than every month.

LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

- Karen announced that the Grass Roots Program is going well, but needs 4 more Math and 2 more Reading Tutors.
- ➤ The summer reading program was a big success with around 400 kids attending.
- Kiwanis has donated about 200 books.
- > The Writer's Group will continue to meet at the Library and at the BrewGallery.

DISCUSSIONS:

- The possibility of using the Pelican Café as the venue for holding a Friends of the Library end-of-year or January event or maybe a Mystery night.
- > The possibility of "re-branding" the Library's Logo using the Town's Logo with books replacing the tower.
- ➤ The possibility of replacing Library Cards with BioMetric's finger print identification has been tabled because of the non-responsiveness of Sirsi Dynix representatives.

MONTHLY REPORT

April 2015

The following activities or items of significance occurred from January to April

- The Writers' Group members continue to meet each Saturday, sometimes meeting at the Brewhouse Gallery.
- Planning a new monument sign for the front of the library and installing a temporary one for the interim.
- Friends sponsored author book discussion and signing for author, Juan Plaza
- Participated in the Lake Park Elementary School's Family Reading Enrichment Night.
- Held a Library Strategic Planning Workshop in March. Commission, resident patrons, Friends and Library Board are invited to participate. Thirteen people were in attendance.

The following statistics may be of interest:

- The Lake Park Kiwanis chapter, through the *Edie's Corner* program, has provided over 300 new books to the children's library this year.
- Zinio is now added to our library website and anyone with a Lake Park Public Library card can now access over 100 magazines on their computer or device from any location.
- The Mel Fisher exhibit on the history of human trafficking was displayed in the main area of the library. 12 people attended the related workshop on January 21.
- The Friends' annual "Big Book Sale" was not held on the Library front lawn due to questionable weather on Saturday, January 28th. Local Teens manned the outside tent to bring people indoors. The Friends had received nearly \$400. in donations by way of the event.

During the next month, library staff will be working on the following:

- Updating the youth library collection
- Continue upgrading the main areas of the library interior and patio
- Upgrading public and staff computers
- Preparing the 2015 Summer Reading Program
- Preparing for the start of the 2016 budget process
- Drafting a new library monthly E-newsletter and blog
- Installing new hardware and software to replace outdated public computers
