

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TOWN BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 AS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 19-2004 ; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission has previously established the budget for the Town of Lake Park for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2004 and ending September 2005; and

WHEREAS, at the time of its adoption, the budget properly reflected expected revenues and appropriations; and

WHEREAS, to implement this budget, the Town Commission adopted and levied by Ordinance No.18-2004 a tentative and final millage rate for the fiscal year 2004-2005; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission deems it necessary and advisable to amend the budget for the Town of Lake Park for fiscal year 2004-2005; which was adopted in Ordinance No.19-2004

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK FLORIDA:

Section 1. An amended final budget of the Town of Lake Park has been duly prepared by the Town Manager and has been reviewed by the Town Commission, upon proper notice at public hearing, and the same is hereby adopted for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2004 and ending September 30, 2005 as follows:

An amended final budget is hereby approved and adopted in the sum of \$12,818,447.00, a copy of which is incorporated by reference along with approved budget amendments made a part hereof and which include among others, the following items.

Section 2. Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida and the Charter and Code of the Town of Lake Park, the object and purpose of the appropriations provided for by this Ordinance and the amount of each function of the government of the Town is hereby fixed, made and appropriated in accordance with the terms, specification and details contained within the said budget.

Section 3. The Town Manager is hereby authorized to amend/transfer authorization between departmental accounts provided; however, that total appropriated expenditures by fund do not exceed Commission authorized amounts.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phase or portion of the Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 5. All ordinances, including but not limited to Ordinance No. and/or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Upon First Reading this 18th day of May, 2005 the foregoing ORDINANCE was offered by Vice Mayor Garretson who moved its approval. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Balius, and being put to a vote, the result was as follows:
