Attached please find the referenced questions and the response to each as was discussed in the pre-bid meeting of November 17, 2003:

- 1. Is Builders Risk Insurance going to be required?
 - The Town will not require the Builders Risk Insurance. The Town would recommend however that the Contractor obtain such insurance to protect their interests.
- 2. What will the provision be for unsuitable material?
 - The Town will supply a copy of the borings that were provided by Dunkelburger Engineering. It does not depict any unsuitable material, however the Town will place a bid line item for excavation of unsuitable material and compacted embankment. This does not include the embankment to construct the building pad, that embankment is to be included in the price for the pad construction line item.

- 3. Can the Town provide copies of the plans for the waterside construction and the proposed utilities?
 - The Town has made one copy of the plans for each Company that paid for the bid package and attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting.
- 4. Is the Town willing to allow the Contractor to use Gas for the proposed facility?
 - The Town will provide a line item to the Bid for using Gas. The complete design, permitting and installation shall be included in the bid line item.
- 5. Can the Town provide the requirements for the types of equipment to be used in the laundry Facility?
 - The Town will provide the machines and the Contractor shall supply all of the electrical, gas, vents, drains and other apparatus as necessary for the installation of said equipment.
 - 6. Due to time constraints can the town extend the Bid Opening date?
 - The Town will reschedule the opening to December 8, 2003 at 10:00 AM in the Town Commission chambers located at 535 Park Ave. Lake Park FL. 33403
 - 7. Can the Town extend the Construction time to 150 days after receipt of permit?




