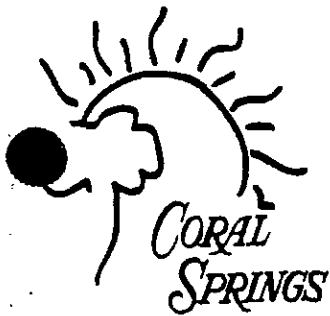

We had a business to run during the construction of this building and at no time did anything take place that hindered our work.

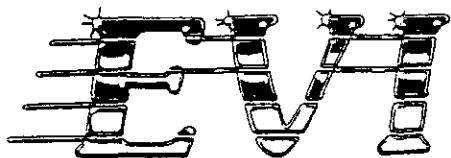

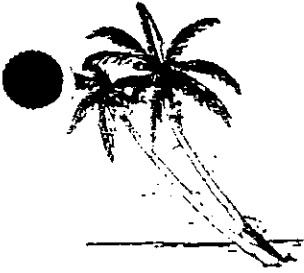


Rybovich Spencer is extremely pleased with the work that you performed recently in renovating/modernizing our 66' wide x 128' long x 38' high dry storage/repair building.


