Commissioners Reveal Their Top Priorities for 2019

Think of them as New Year's resolutions for the Town Commission.

Lake Park commissioners have unveiled what they see as priorities for the upcoming year.

Topping the list is increasing and improving youth recreation programs. City leaders say increasing access to the programs would benefit a lot of families across the town. It would also, according to city staff, help build community bonds and lower crime by giving kids an after-school activity.


Also making the list is doing more to make the public aware of all the programs and opportunities available, following up on marketing and public relations plans promoting Lake Park, and creating a traffic calming policy.

Commissioners also called for making crime watch stats more public. City leaders want more people to know how safe the community actually is, hopefully combatting more negative perceptions.

City staff will use the Commissioners' 2019 goals as guidance to set their own agendas and plans for the upcoming year.

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity has launched Rebuild Florida to help low to moderate income families whose homes were significantly damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Irma repair or rebuild their homes. This includes homeowners or properties that are rented to families with low or moderate incomes.
